



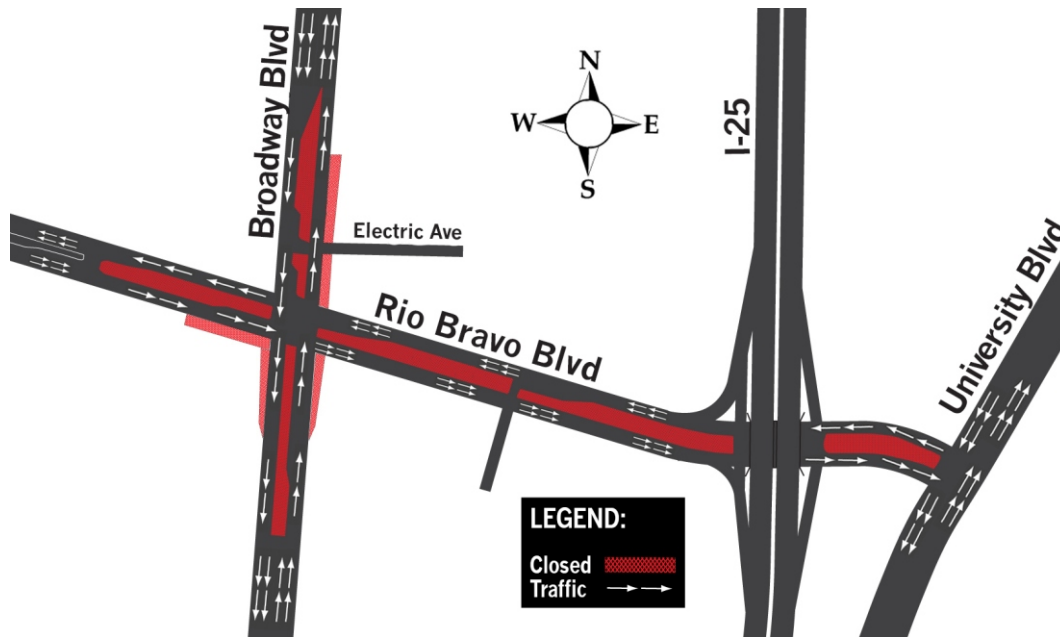
## Construction Begins Tuesday, August 8

**I-25/RIO BRAVO INTERCHANGE** construction is expected to take about two years to complete. Regular work hours will be **7 a.m.-5 p.m. daily Monday-Sunday**, although crews may work at night if required. Construction on Phase O will begin on **Tuesday, August 8, 2017** and is expected to last through early or mid-September. During this phase of construction:

The inside eastbound and west-bound lanes of Rio Bravo will be closed from University to east of Chavez Loop Trail  
The inside northbound and southbound lanes of Broadway will be closed near Rio Bravo  
Northbound and southbound shoulders on I-25 will be closed south of the I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange  
The multi-use path will be closed east of Chavez Loop Road for the duration of the project

Travel will continue to flow as usual on I-25. Two lanes of traffic will remain open in each direction on Rio Bravo west of I-25, and one lane of traffic will remain open in each direction on Broadway, **but motorists should expect delays, particularly during morning and afternoon commutes.**

Here are a couple of alternate routes to the Zia Range:

Continue south on I-25 and take exit 215. It is marked:

Exit 215 South 47 Broadway

At the fork of the off ramp, stay to the right onto north bound Broadway to Bobby Foster.

Or

Get off I-25 at Gibson, go west to Broadway and south on Broadway to Bobby Foster. Just be aware that the intersection of Rio Bravo and Broadway will be congested.
