## Zia BOD Minutes, January 11, 2018, Annual Meeting

The January 11, 2018 BOD Annual meeting began at 0700 p.m. with President Charles Moots presiding. The meeting was held at the Albuquerque Sheraton Hotel, 2600 Louisiana, Albuquerque, NM. A quorum of voting members was not achieved (79). A quorum of the BOD was achieved, so the meeting was held in accordance with Club By-Laws Article V, Section 6 (d) with 17/21 BOD members attending.

**Item I-Approval of Minutes and Agenda-** The minutes of December 21, 2017 were approved with no changes. The agenda was approved with no changes. There were no additions to the agenda.

**Item II-Treasurer's Report** The Treasurer's report was presented by Treasurer Cleary. He reported on the very healthy financial status of the Club. Various indicators were: Very low insufficient funds rate for membership, highly stable membership totals of ~1600 total members, high use of the range facilities with no reported safety incidents for the year, healthy profits in all major areas of the club activities with a more than \$74,000 net profit for the annual period. The range also has a zero debt liability and a total current asset balance in excess of \$700,000, not including several equipment investments.

**Item III-Old Business-** The business meeting was held by President Moots. There were no By-Law change proposals and no dues changes proposals. The **Ballot** will be further published in February and March newsletters for mail-in in order to complete the BOD election. The results will be tabulated at the March BOD meeting and published in the April Newsletter. Other **significant dates** for membership renewal were discussed and as published in this month's agenda.

**Item IV-New Business- Junior Shooter Presentation-**The BOD received a presentation by Ms. Emily Fitzgerald of the Valencia County 4H Junior Shooting Sports youth shooters. Emily thanked the BOD and the assembled members for the strong and effective financial and facilities support which Zia has provided this small group. She indicated these shooters would not have been able to attend the several out of town events without this Zia support. Their latest event was to attend the Winter Air Gun Match at the Olympic Training Center, Colorado Springs, Colorado this past December at which they won several awards. **Drawings** for general membership and guest prizes followed. A **grand prize** drawing for a **Kimber Pro Carry II pistol** resulted in the winning ticket being held by member Paul Ussery, #7437170. The pistol was a prize won by Zia at the "Friends of the NRA banquet held this past November, and donated by the BOD to the club members for this Annual Zia Meeting. The weapon was on display at the meeting. The winner may take possession following appropriate processing. The fee for this processing was donated by **Los Ranchos Gun Shop**, Mark Abramson, owner. **Door prize drawings** followed, supervised by Chair Ron Bjornberg. Everyone with a complementary ticket received a prize.

**Rules:** Current NRA Smallbore Rifle and Smallbore Hunting Rifle Silhouette Rules as well as this program Apply.

**Competition Open to:** Zia Rifle and Pistol Club Members and their Guests

**Type of Match:** Classified, Squadded Individual Match. Smallbore Rifle and Smallbore Hunter Will run concurrently.

**Entries:** All entries will be Post Entries and will be accepted from 8:00am until 8:45am day of match.

**Entries close:** 8:45am day of Match

**Entry Limit:** 24

**Registration Fee / Entry fee:** No registration or entry fee. If a Competitor does not have a 2018 Rifle Silhouette Classification Score Record Book, they will be available at cost. This book covers all Rifle Silhouette disciplines.

**Firing Starts:** First relay starts at 9:10am, after Safety Meeting

**Course of Fire:** Smallbore Rifle Silhouette Match Course of 40 shots – two series of five shots each at Gallina (chicken) 40m; Javelina (pig) 60m; Guajolote (turkey) 77m; Borrego (ram) 100m. 1/5 scale NRA Smallbore Metallic silhouettes will be used. All shooting is done from the standing position with no artificial support.

**Classification of Competitors:** NRA Classification (for 40 shot match)

Smallbore Rifle – Master 34-40; AAA28-33; AA21-27; A15-20; B0-14

Smallbore Hunting Rifle – Master 32-40; AAA26-31; AA20-25; A15-19; B0-14

Beginners without classification may fire their first match as Unclassified, except those with an NRA classification of Master in other shooting sports will fire in the AAA class. The resulting scores will set their initial classification.

**Awards:** Certificates, based on the number of competitors in the class. Minimum for an award is two (2) competitors in a class. Awards will be issued after scores are posted at the end of the match.

**Award Schedule:** 2 or more competitors - up to 4th place. 5-in-a-row and 10-in-a-row pins will be awarded. 10-in-a-row runs will be submitted to the NRA for the Grand Slam Silhouette Club.

### **Equipment:**

Smallbore Silhouette Rifles will conform to the NRA Rifle Silhouette Rules Sect. 3.2 and 3.1.

Smallbore Hunting Silhouette Rifles will conform to NRA Rifle Silhouette Rules Sect. 3.2.1 and 3.1.1

Details from these sections are attached to this program.

Only factory loaded .22 caliber short, long, or long rifle rimfire cartridges is allowed. Hot loads, such as “Stingers”, are not permitted.

Slings, palm rests, hook butt plates, adjustable butt plates, shooting gloves, rifle shooting coats, or other clothing, equipment or attachments as an aide to shooting are prohibited.

**Safety:** The use of Open Bolt Indicators (OBI) or Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) is required for competitors.

**General Information:** Bring your own food and water, none available at the range. Porta-potty available

**Official Rules for Silhouette Rifle Matches**

### 3. RIFLES, EQUIPMENT AND AMMUNITION

**CERTIFICATION OF RIFLES:** Rifles must be weighed, measured and certified before being fired in a match. The rifle must be fired in the same configuration as when certified. No one may win an award with an uncertified rifle. In rifle competition, loads that damage targets may be disapproved by the Range Officer or Jury. In case of a malfunction certified by the Range Officer or Jury, a replacement rifle must be certified. (See Rule 9.8)

#### RIFLES

**3.2 Smallbore Silhouette Rifle** - Identical to the description of the High Power Silhouette Rifle, except that the rifle shall be chambered for only factory loaded .22 caliber short, long or long rifle rimfire cartridges. Hot loads, such as "Stingers", are not permitted. See Rule 3.17.

**3.1 High Power Silhouette Rifle** - A rifle, caliber 6mm or larger, provided no belted cartridges or Magnums are allowed, meeting the following specifications:

(a) Maximum weight 10 pounds, 2 ounces, including sights.

(b) Any sights, telescopic or metallic may be used.

Scopes may not be more than 2 inches above the rifle as measured from the top of the receiver to the underside of the scope tube, nor may the scope be offset from the top center line of the receiver. Any sighting device programmed to activate the firing mechanisms is prohibited.

(c) Any trigger not subject to accidental discharge. Triggers which function on release are not permitted. In the event of accidental discharge, the Range Officer shall require trigger adjustment or replacement of the rifle.

(d) Stock: The stock must be traditionally styled and may not be bent and/or twisted so as to deviate from conventional configurations such as factory rifle stocks or silhouette stocks as manufactured by Fajen, McMillan, H-S Precision, and others. The forend, including the trigger guard mounts and screws, shall not exceed 2 1/4 inches wide, and 2 1/4 inches deep measured from the centerline of the bore. Magazines do not have to conform to stock measurements but those that extend below the stock line may not be used as support as per Rule 3.1(h) and 3.14. The forend shall extend a minimum of 8 inches forward of the forward edge of the receiver ring. The comb shall not extend above the centerline of the bore, but Monte Carlo roll may rise 1/2 inch on the off side. Buttplate or recoil pad may not extend below the lower line of the stock.

(e) Attachments which do not cause any portion of the rifle to exceed the weight or dimensions as listed herein are permitted provided they do not extend past the end of the barrel. Sighting devices are not considered "attachments".

(f) Trigger guard must be present and may not vary from conventional configuration for the purpose of providing added thumb or palm support and shall be no deeper than 1 5/16 inches below the bottom line of the forend. (Note: TIC Contender Carbines and Ruger Single Shot rifles are exempt, provided the additional depth of the trigger guard is not used as palm or thumb support.)

(g) The barrel may be no longer than 30 inches including any sleeve or attachment, as measured from the face of the closed bolt to the end of the barrel.

(h) Exceptions: U.S. Rifle caliber .30 M1, M14 and M1A. These rifles only may exceed the weight limit. Telescopic sights are not permitted. The magazine of the M1A or M14 may not be used as a palm rest.

**3.2.1 Smallbore Hunting Silhouette Rifle** - Identical to the description of the High Power Hunting Silhouette Rifle, except that (a) the rifle may be a single-loading rifle, (b) the weight may not exceed 8 1/2 pounds, (c) the rifle shall be chambered for only factory loaded .22 caliber short, long or long rifle rimfire cartridges, and (d) barrel turners or additional weights are not permitted.

**3.1.1 High Power Hunting Silhouette Rifle** - A hunting style rifle having a maximum weight of 9 pounds, including sights and if applicable, an empty magazine or clip. The intent of this rule is to describe a common hunting rifle.

(a) Caliber: 6mm or larger, provided that no belted cartridges or Magnums are allowed.

(b) Sights: any telescopic or metallic sight may be used. Scopes may not be more than 1.5 inches above the rifle, as measured from the top of the receiver to the underside of the scope tube, nor may the scope be offset from the centerline of the bore.

Exception: for rifles that eject the empty cartridge case straight up and that normally use an offset scope, the scope may be offset. Any sighting device programmed to activate the firing mechanism is prohibited.

(c) Stock: A hunting style stock; thumbhole-type stocks are not permitted. Attachments, either removable or permanent, are not permitted. Swivels and slings are permitted, but slings may not be used for arm support in shooting. Dimensions may not exceed those described in 3.1(d).

(d) Trigger: Trigger pull shall not be less than 2 pounds. In the event of an accidental discharge, range officers shall require adjustment of the trigger or replacement of the rifle. Rifles must be equipped with a functional safety. All safety features, including any manual safety, must be functional.

(e) Barrel: A hunting style contoured barrel that tapers from chamber to muzzle. Bull barrels are not permitted. A factory tuner that does not act as a muzzle brake or compensator is permitted. Maximum barrel length is 26 inches, including tuner. (See Rule 3.16.1).

(f) Magazines: Magazines may not be loaded with more than 5 rounds.

- 14. \_\_\_\_ The Tunnel Range hatch cover is not a target stand. It serves as a gate when firing is in progress.

16. \_\_\_\_ On the Shotgun Range, fire only in the direction of west to south between the white posts.
- 16a. \_\_\_\_ The area west and the area South of the main Shotgun Range is closed except for Specific Activity functions.
17. \_\_\_\_ The Shotgun Range is considered separate from the High Power and Metallic Silhouette Ranges and does not require the flag to be raised.
18. \_\_\_\_ On the Shotgun Range do not use shot larger than #7.5.
19. \_\_\_\_ It is OK to leave clay bird launchers in a cocked condition when you leave the Shotgun Range.
20. \_\_\_\_ There is no need to pick up spent shells when shooting is complete on the Shotgun Range.
21. \_\_\_\_ The High Power and Metallic Silhouette ranges are considered as one for Range Officer control and the area between the Metallic Silhouette range and the east fence is for activity use only.
22. \_\_\_\_ Before using either the High Power or Metallic ranges, and the flag is already raised, and no one is evident, you must physically inspect the ranges before beginning shooting activity.
23. \_\_\_\_ Do not mount targets on the T-stands or gong hangers on the Metallic Silhouette Range.
24. \_\_\_\_ The first shooter on a range is the acting Range Officer for that range.
25. \_\_\_\_ You may pack up your equipment and firearms during a cease fire.
26. \_\_\_\_ Memberships expire on April 1 of each year. Keys may be de-activated at anytime after that date.
27. \_\_\_\_ There is no penalty for mistakenly calling a cease-fire.
28. \_\_\_\_ Law enforcement officers not on official business and those with carry permits may carry loaded firearms on Zia.
29. \_\_\_\_ Place your targets in front of the berms, not on top of the berms.
30. \_\_\_\_ You may handle, load and fire your weapon(s) (including cased weapons) only after the Range Officer has called the range "Hot".
31. \_\_\_\_ The patterning board on the shotgun range may only be used at a distance of 20 yards or more and only with size 7.5 shot or smaller.
32. \_\_\_\_ **Magnum calibers, armor piercing rounds and other enhanced penetration designs may not be fired at steel targets.**
33. \_\_\_\_ You must case or bag your loaded firearm before bringing it to a "hot" firing line.
34. \_\_\_\_ Incendiary, exploding and /or tracer ammunition is strictly prohibited on all Zia Ranges due to extreme fire danger.
35. \_\_\_\_ **Any individual member may be suspended or expelled for conduct contrary to or in violation of, the By-Laws of the Club, or the Club Range Safety Regulations and rules of Conduct, false or misleading statements to obtain membership, or other reason(s) deemed sufficient by the club. (By-Laws).**
36. \_\_\_\_ **Members are expected to pick up their own trash, used targets, spent cases, etc. and place them in the receptacles provided.**
