

10. _____ Legally registered class III and bump-fire weapons are limited to the western practice (plinking) ranges.

10a. DO NOT USE SHOTGUNS on OR DESTROY THE ZIA TARGET FRAMES!

11. _____ The practice ranges are the only berms where other than standard paper or steel targets are permitted.

12, _____ Each Action Pistol range is considered separate for Range Officer control.

13. _____ Steel Targets are not permitted on the eastern-most Action Pistol range.

14. _____ The Tunnel Range hatch cover is not a target stand. It serves as a gate when firing is in progress.

15. _____ Turn out lights, turn off the fan, clean up the area and secure all doors before leaving the tunnel range.

16. _____ On the Shotgun Range, fire only in the direction of west to south between the white posts. 16a. ____ The area west and the area South of the main Shotgun Range is closed except for Specific Activity functions.

17. _____ The Shotgun Range is considered separate from the High Power and Metallic Silhouette Ranges and does not require the flag to be raised.

18. _____ On the Shotgun Range do not use shot larger than #7.5.

19. _____ It is OK to leave clay bird launchers in a cocked condition when you leave the Shotgun Range.

20.____ There is no need to pick up spent shells when shooting is complete on the Shotgun Range.

21. _____ The High Power and Metallic Silhouette ranges are considered as one for Range Officer control and the area between the Metallic Silhouette range and the east fence is for activity use only.
22. _____ Before using either the High Power or Metallic ranges, and the flag is already raised, and no one is evident, you must physically inspect the ranges before beginning shooting activity.

23. ____ Do not mount targets on the T-stands or gong hangers on the Metallic Silhouette Range.

24. _____ The first shooter on a range is the acting Range Officer for that range.

25. _____ You may pack up your equipment and firearms during a cease fire.

26. _____ Memberships expire on April 1 of each year. Keys may be de-activated at anytime after that date.

27. _____ There is no penalty for mistakenly calling a cease-fire.

28. _____ Law enforcement officers not on official business and those with carry permits may carry loaded firearms on Zia.

29. _____ Place your targets in front of the berms, not on top of the berms.

30. _____ You may handle, load and fire your weapon(s) (including cased weapons) only after the Range Officer has called the range "Hot".

31. _____The patterning board on the shotgun range may only be used at a distance of 20 yards or more and only with size 7.5 shot or smaller.

32. <u>Magnum calibers, armor piercing rounds and other enhanced penetration designs may not</u> be fired at steel targets.

33. _____ You must case or bag your loaded firearm before bringing it to a "hot" firing line.

34. _____ Incendiary, exploding and /or tracer ammunition is strictly prohibited on all Zia Ranges due to extreme fire danger.

35. _____ Any individual member may be suspended or expelled for conduct contrary to or in violation of, the By-Laws of the Club, or the Club Range Safety Regulations and rules of Conduct, false or misleading statements to obtain membership, or other reason(s) deemed sufficient by the club. (By-Laws).

36.____ Members are expected to pick up their own trash, used targets, spent cases, etc. and place them in the receptacles provided.

37.____ Members are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that promotes a safe and friendly environment. Foul language, displays of anger and unsportsmanlike conduct could be grounds for a member being suspended or expelled from Zia.

38. _____ Any reported safety violation will result in appearance before the Board of Directors (BOD) and repetition of the range safety course as a minimum.

39. _____ Members of all categories are responsible for knowing the contents of the Range Safety Regulations and Rules of Conduct and complying therewith.

40. _____ The Board of Directors meetings are open to all club members.

41. _____ Any member present may be given the floor at BOD meetings and be heard at the discretion of the Chairperson, but only members of the Board have a vote in the proceedings.

Bloomberg-Backed Anti-Gun Organizations Demanding MORE Gun Control

Dear New Mexico NRA Member:

The New Mexico Legislature began its 30-day budget session on January 18th and Bloomberg-backed national anti-gun organizations are already demanding more gun control!

Last fall, representatives from Bloomberg's Everytown for Gun Safety testified before an interim committee that the Legislature needed to pass a bill imposing state-mandated firearm storage restrictions. Their "gold standard" for firearm storage is requiring New Mexico gun owners to store all guns unloaded, locked and separate from ammunition at all times when not in use. Such a proposal is not only unenforceable, but also defies logic, as it renders firearms unusable for self-defense in the middle of a drastic spike in violent crime. Our Nation's capital had a similar firearm storage law that was struck down in the D.C. v. Heller Supreme Court case. The Heller decision found that restricting immediate access to legally-owned firearms was unconstitutional. But that's not stopping gun control advocates from trying to pass such a bill here in New Mexico. In fact, Everytown is already running digital ads demanding the New Mexico Legislature enact a so-called "secure storage" law!

Please contact your State Senators and State Representatives and tell them NO MORE GUN CONTROL and NO MANDATORY STORAGE REQUIREMENTS! No specific bills have been filed yet on this topic, but the bill introduction deadline is not until February 2.

Please also contact Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham and tell her NO MORE GUN CONTROL and NO MANDATORY STORAGE REQUIREMENTS! Bills which are not budget-related may only be considered during the 30-day session if they receive a message from the governor.

Mandatory Storage/Child Access Prevention (CAP) Legislation-Talking Points

Requiring guns to be kept locked and unloaded renders them useless for self-defense purposes. One-size fits all approaches to gun storage/safety do not account for different families' circumstances or children's level of familiarity with or understanding of firearms.

These laws are unnecessary; New Mexico already has laws on the books to hold adults accountable for endangering a child. (*NMSA Section 30-6-1, New Mexico's Child Abuse/Abandonment statute*). Under the law, it is a felony for a responsible person to knowingly, intentionally, or negligently, and without justifiable cause, cause or permit a child to be placed in a situation that may endanger the child's life or health. Prosecutors have the tools, in appropriate cases, to hold parents, guardians or other custodians of children accountable when a child gains unauthorized access to a firearm and commits a crime or injures himself or someone else.

These laws are ineffective. According to a study by John R. Lott, Jr., PhD, and John Whitley, "<u>Safe Storage</u> <u>Gun Laws: Accidental Deaths, Suicides, and Crime,</u>" - there is no evidence that CAP laws reduce either juvenile accidental firearm deaths or suicides. Instead, these laws appear to make it harder for lawabiding gun owners to protect themselves. Out of ten states studied that had CAP laws for at least four years, relative violent crime stopped falling when these statutes were adopted and then ended up even higher at the end the four-year period. The only consistent impact was that these laws were significantly related to higher rates of rape, robbery, and burglary.

These laws have a chilling effect on youth participation in firearm-related activities and they may be unconstitutional. Language in these laws set potential legal traps for responsible parents whose children participate in legitimate recreational, training and competitive activities and could be unconstitutional. Additionally, the United States Supreme Court struck down as invalid laws that require "firearms in the home be rendered and kept inoperable at all times." (*District of Columbia v. Heller*) The Court affirmed that "the need for defense of self, family, and property is most acute" in the home and the Second Amendment "elevates above all other interests" the right "to use arms in defense of hearth and home." (*Heller*) Clearly, a firearm meant for home defense must be accessible and operable.
